



Welcome to the Lakeside Early Bird Club, the 'breakfast club' offering quality childcare for Lakeside School pupils (Reception – Year 6) from 7.40 am until 8.45 am, Mondays to Fridays. Please note, however, that the Early Bird Club does not run during school holidays or on Inset Days.

Due to Covid-19, the club is currently situated in Hall 2 where children are looked after by qualified members of staff and can participate in any of the activities on offer daily, before being taken to their classrooms at 8.45am. All children are seated on separate 'year group' tables to ensure children do not cross other bubbles.

To ensure limiting visitors on the school site, we ask for all KS1 children to be accompanied to the Hall 2 side door to be signed in. KS2 children can independently make their own way to the Hall 2 side door where Mrs Hearshaw will sign them in.

Breakfast is included in the £5.00 daily charge and consists of toast with various spreads and a vast choice of cereals and fruit. On Fridays the children are offered a 'Friday special' breakfast which can be either cheese on toast, bacon sandwiches or beans / spaghetti on toast.

The club does not have facilities to look after children who are unwell and therefore we ask you to fill in a contact/medical sheet for each child giving us information of any medical/dietary issues, together with contact numbers of at least two people who would be able to collect your child in the event of an emergency between 7.40am - 8.45am. These may well be different contacts or phone numbers from the ones held in the School Office which are used during school hours.

If your child is displaying symptoms of Covid-19, please do not send them to the club and contact the school office to register their absence.

Bookings for the club can be made online via Scopay which will be activated once your child is registered. Payment must be made at the time of booking sessions. If you would like to make payment using childcare vouchers, which may be available through your employer, please contact the school office.

Please note that parking in the staff car park is NOT allowed as teachers are arriving at this time.
