

Geography

We will be learning the names of the 4 countries within the United Kingdom, some traditions from these countries and what their capital cities are.

RE

We have 2 RE topics this half term. One is call 'What do Christians believe God is like?' and the other is 'What do eggs have to do with Easter?'

Science

We will be recognising and naming animals in the UK. We will learn how to look after animals in our local area and learn what the words herbivore, carnivore and omnivore mean.

Phonics

We will be continuing with our Phase 5 learning from Letters and Sounds. We will be looking at all the different spellings for sounds and learning new 'tricky words' which need to be learnt by sight.

Maths

We will be looking at 'Place value' within 20. This will include an introduction to 'tens' and 'ones' (units). We will also begin to cover addition and subtraction with 20 using previous and new methods.

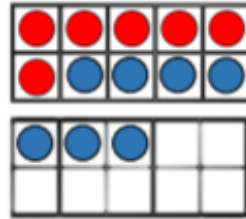
