We will be continuing the animal theme and exploring animals from around the world! We will learn what the words herbivore, carnivore and omnivore mean.

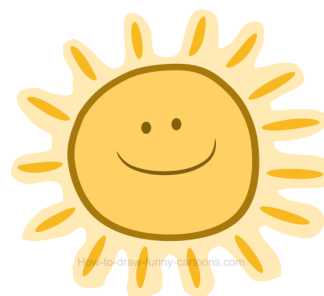
Phonics

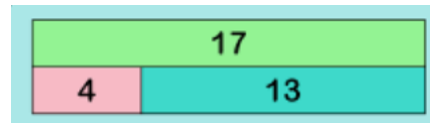
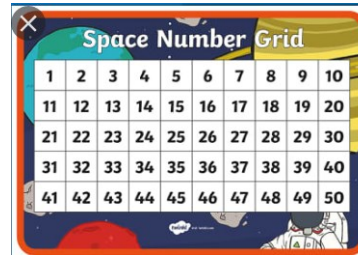
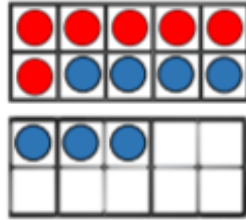
