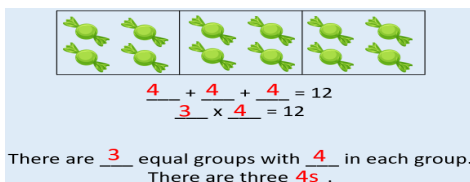

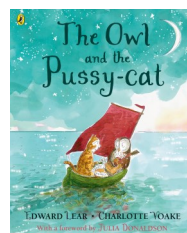

- **Key Texts** : The Bear under the stairs, The owl and the pussy cat
- Whole class reading—The ice monster, Christmasaurus
- Listening, discussing and expressing views about a text.
- Planning, writing and editing.—reading their own writing to check it makes sense, proof-reading and editing, checking for errors in punctuation.
- Exploring: types of sentences— statements, exclamation, command & question
- Skills: Using capital letters and full stops consistently, begin using apostrophes and commas. Continue using expanded noun phrases for description and discussing grammatical terminology
