Compare, describe and solve practical problems for: lengths and heights.

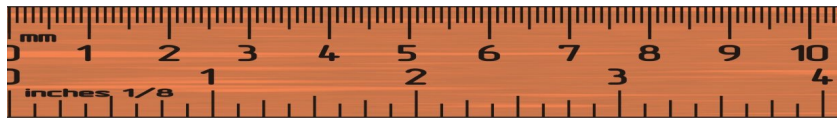
Measure and begin to record lengths and heights.

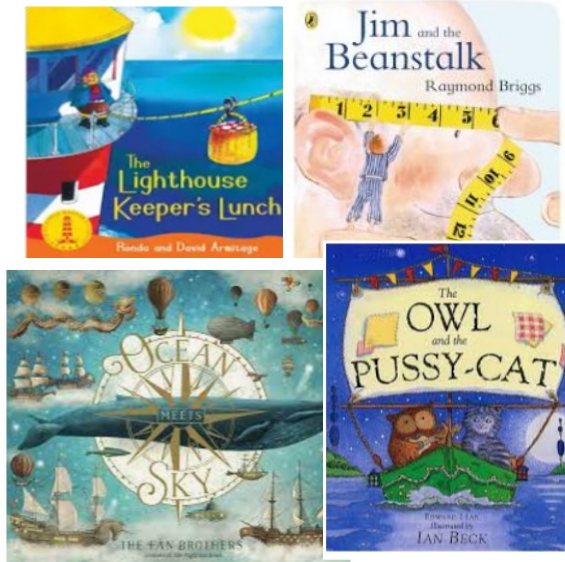
