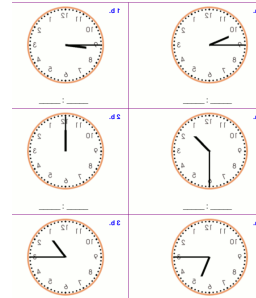
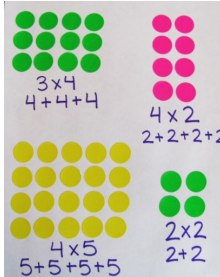
Maths

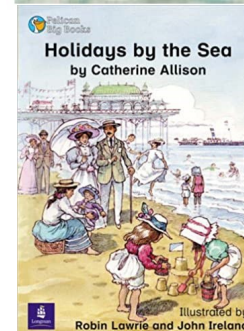
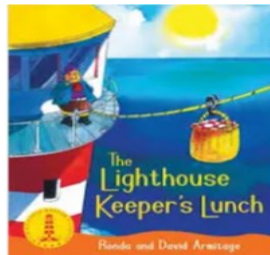
