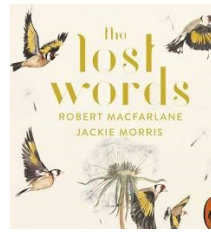
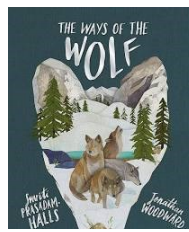
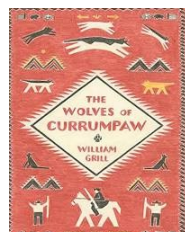
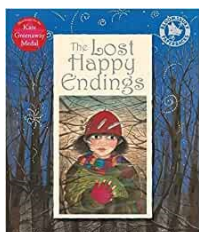


## Key dates
