- Measure heartrate and see how it changes during exercise (linking to science work)

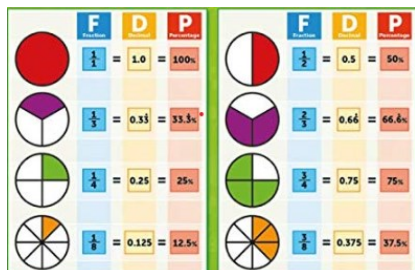
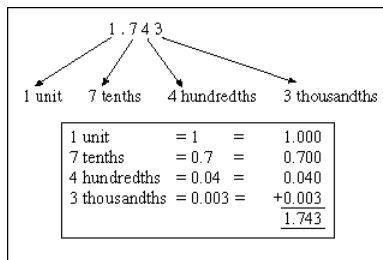

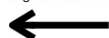

### Multiplying and Dividing by 10, 100 and 1000

#### Multiplying

X 10    digits move LEFT 1 space  
X 100    digits move LEFT 2 spaces  
X 1000    digits move LEFT 3 spaces



#### Dividing

÷ 10    digits move RIGHT 1 space  
÷ 100    digits move RIGHT 2 spaces  
÷ 1000    digits move RIGHT 3 spaces
